



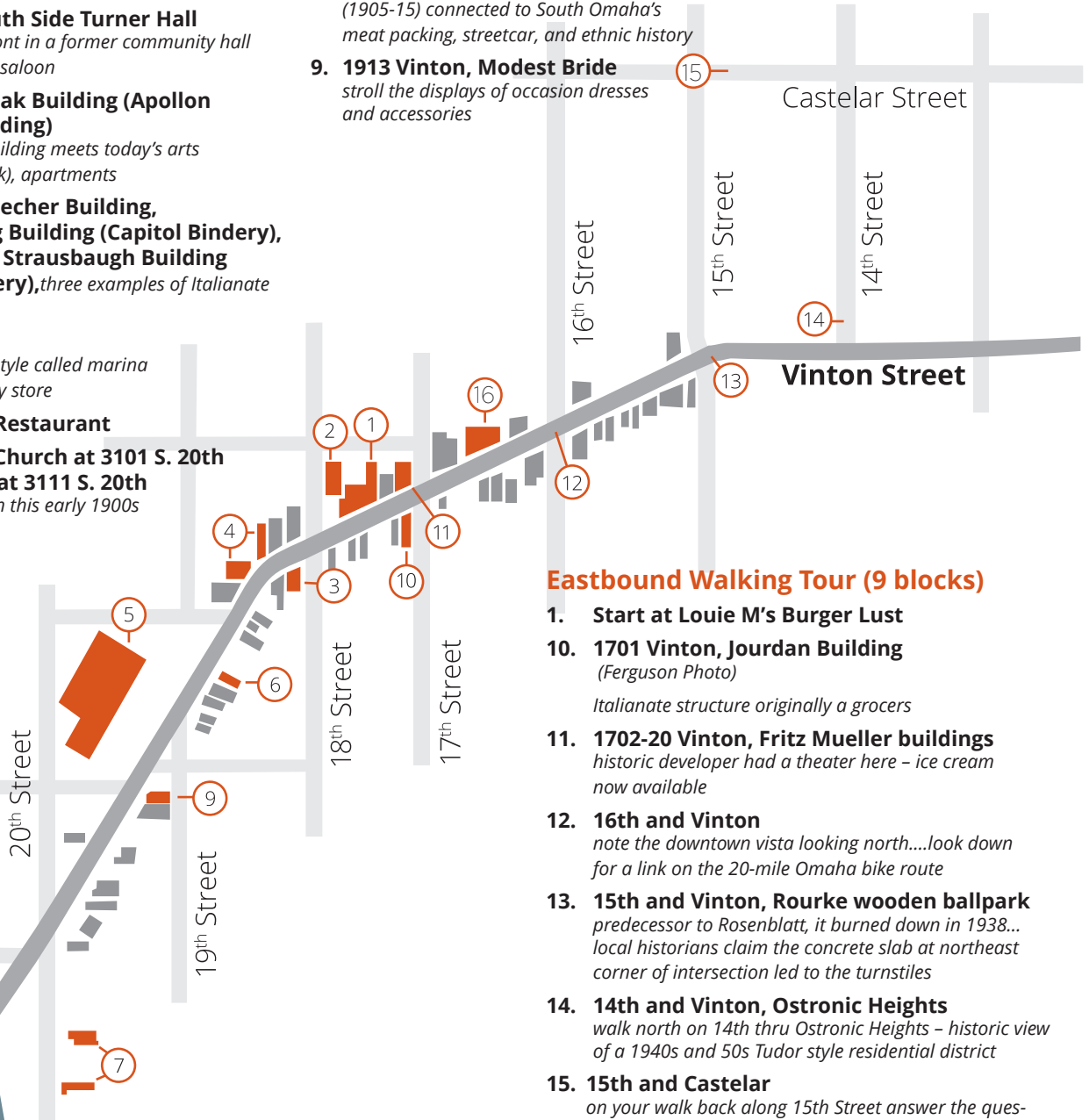
Walking Tour of Historic Vinton Street

The Vinton Street Historic District is comprised of 16 buildings built from 1890 to 1923 and is registered as a National Historic Place. The street grid pattern that meets the diagonal Vinton creates irregular lots and skewed building fronts. Groups of 3 or more can arrange a Vinton tour. Westbound Walking Tour (9 blocks)

1. **Start at Louie M's Burger Lust**
look east and west to see a commercial district serving South Omaha in many ways for over 125 years
2. **1724 Vinton, South Side Turner Hall**
note the Moderne front in a former community hall and rumored Schlitz saloon
3. **1801 Vinton, Vasak Building (Apollon & Hardware Building)**
historic hardware building meets today's arts and greenery (in back), apartments
4. **1806 Vinton Schlecher Building, 1812 Vinton Wiig Building (Capitol Bindery), and 1816 Vinton Strausbaugh Building (Olvera Upholstery), three examples of Italianate architecture**
5. **Supermercado**
1950s supermarket style called marina - originally a Safeway store
6. **Taqueria El Ray Restaurant**
7. **Cross Lutheran Church at 3101 S. 20th and Old OFD #3 at 3111 S. 20th**
occupied residence in this early 1900s Omaha fire station

8. **Armbrust Houses between 21st and 22nd on Vinton**
20 plus refurbished workers cottages (1905-15) connected to South Omaha's meat packing, streetcar, and ethnic history
9. **1913 Vinton, Modest Bride**
stroll the displays of occasion dresses and accessories



Eastbound Walking Tour (9 blocks)

1. **Start at Louie M's Burger Lust**
10. **1701 Vinton, Jourdan Building**
(Ferguson Photo)
Italianate structure originally a grocers
11. **1702-20 Vinton, Fritz Mueller buildings**
historic developer had a theater here - ice cream now available
12. **16th and Vinton**
note the downtown vista looking north...look down for a link on the 20-mile Omaha bike route
13. **15th and Vinton, Rourke wooden ballpark**
predecessor to Rosenblatt, it burned down in 1938... local historians claim the concrete slab at northeast corner of intersection led to the turnstiles
14. **14th and Vinton, Ostronic Heights**
walk north on 14th thru Ostronic Heights - historic view of a 1940s and 50s Tudor style residential district
15. **15th and Castelar**
on your walk back along 15th Street answer the question "what is the difference between cobblestone and brick streets?"
16. **1620 Vinton, Nietos Pasterleria Bakery**
catch a whiff and a taste in a Latino pasteleria
